Attendance

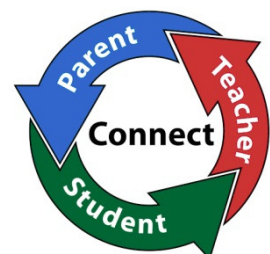
Parents we need your assistance to achieve our goal of 98% attendance by students at school throughout term 3.

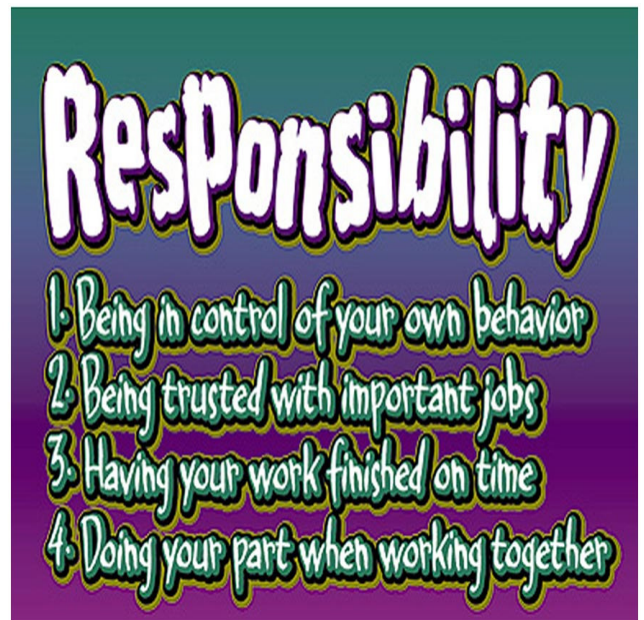
