## Voluntary Contributions for 2026

The Mundijong Primary School Board has approved the Contributions and Charges for 2026. We've put together this information to help you understand any costs that may come up during the school year. The schedule is split into three sections.

### 1. Voluntary Contributions

We are asking families to contribute \$60 per student. This amount is set in line with the maximum allowed under the School Education Regulations 2000.

Your contribution helps us provide extra resources and learning opportunities for our students. The funds go towards things like classroom materials, library resources, and other items that make a big difference to your child's education.

If paying with your stationery order isn't possible, there are other options:

- Direct deposit into the school bank account or EFTPOS (just ask at the office for details).
- Payment plans – if paying the full amount at once is tricky, please call us and we'll happily work out a plan that suits you.

## **2. Charges for Extra Optional Activities**

We've included a breakdown of estimated costs for things like incursions, excursions, and other activities your child might take part in during 2026. These estimates are based on what similar activities have cost in previous years.

Here's what's covered:

- Activities for all students that require payment, like incursions and excursions.
- Programs for selected students, such as PEAC or Instrumental Music.
- Other extras, like school photos and the Year 6 camp.

Please note:

- You'll only be charged for activities your child actually participates in.
- Payments will be requested as each activity comes up.
- The amounts listed are the maximum possible cost for each activity in 2026.


### 3.0 Personal Items for Student Use
