Dear Parents, Caregivers and Students,

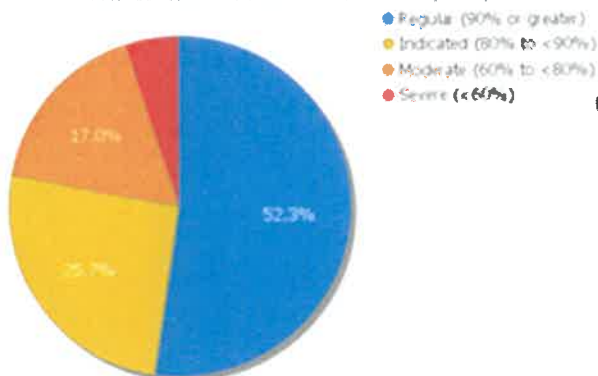

We're looking forward to our Easter Hat Parade on Thursday 2/4 and the P&C Epilepsy Awareness Bake Sale on the same day, to round out our term

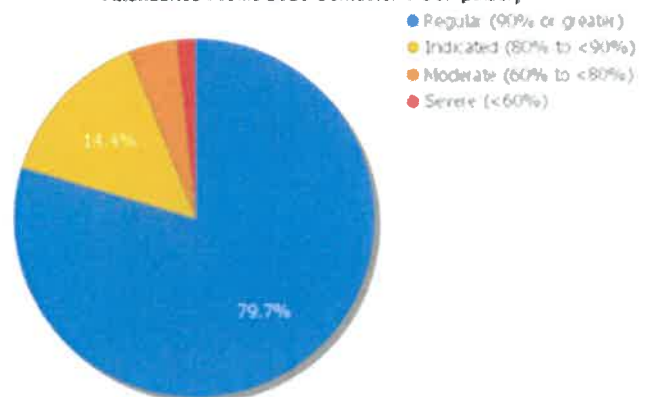
Attendance

Due dropping attendance rates in the second half of 2025, we've created a focus on getting our students to school as much as possible.

As shown in the graph above, only **52.3%** of our students attended school **90% or more** of the time in Semester 2 last year. Our goal is to lift this to **over 65%**.

I am pleased to report that **so far this year we are sitting at almost 80%** of students attending at or above the 90% mark. This represents a significant turnaround. While we do anticipate a slight dip in Term 2 due to winter illnesses, this is still an outstanding result.

However, we continue to have a number of students attending **80% or less** of the time. If this attendance rate were to continue throughout their primary schooling—including Kindy and Pre-Primary—these students would reach high school having effectively missed **more than 1.5 years of formal education**. This places them at a significant disadvantage compared with their peers.

If you are experiencing difficulties getting your child to school regularly, please let us know. We are here to support families and are very keen to work together to address any challenges and help every child succeed.

Term 2 Student Free Days



Next term, students will **return to school on Monday 20 April**. Please note that the School Development Day, which is usually scheduled for the first day back, will instead take place on Friday 29 May.

This date falls the day before the WA Day long weekend and will provide students with a **four-day weekend** in the middle of the term. As a result, **the school will be closed to students on Friday 29 May**.

Please also be aware that the Department of Education now permits schools to close for two days each year solely for the purpose of conducting parent interviews. Therefore, we have scheduled parent interviews for **Wednesday 24 June**.

Semester Reports and Student Progress Reports will be issued to families on Monday 22 June, allowing parents to review their child's progress prior to meeting with teachers.

As interviews will be conducted on this day, **the school will be closed to students on Wednesday 24 June**.

Term 1 Student Progress Reports

Our Student Progress Reports will look a little different this year. We have worked with the Department of Education to expand their reporting platform, allowing us to use it for our Student Progress Reports as well as Semester Reports.

While the format will be different, the reports will contain the same information as in previous years. Instead of receiving a PDF, families will be emailed a secure link to access the reports—just like the Semester Reports.

You will receive the email link and access to the reports on Wednesday 1 April.

Playgrounds- Before and After School

Unfortunately, we need to make the decision to close on-site playgrounds before school, and request that parents and carers vacate the premises within 30 minutes of the school day ending. The key issue is that the school holds 100% duty of care for children while they are on school playgrounds, including before and after school hours. To continue allowing playground access during these times, we would be required to roster staff to supervise each playground, which is particularly challenging before school.

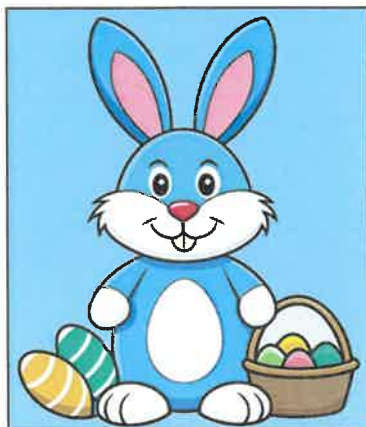
Last Week of Term

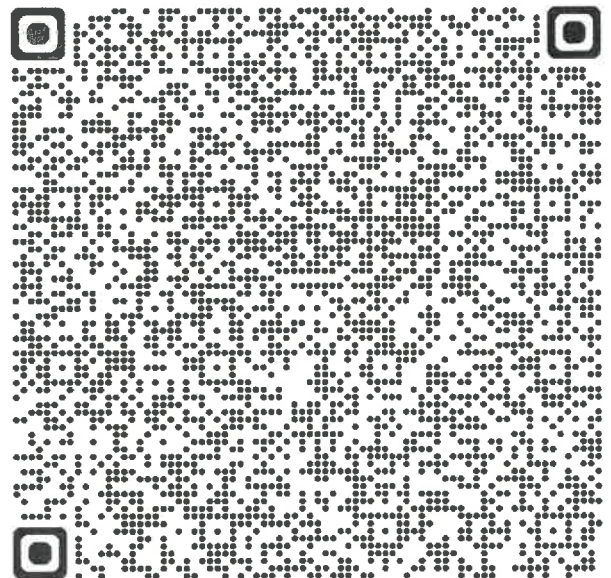

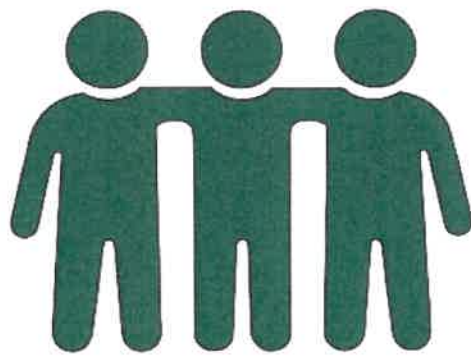
