## PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

Dear Parents, Caregivers and Students,

As we reach the midpoint of a very busy Term 2, I would like to acknowledge the incredible effort of our students, staff, and families. It has been a term filled with learning, growth, and many exciting opportunities across the school.

Term 2 has become a term that is full of extra learning opportunities for our students through the many incursions and excursions.



Last week, we welcomed the **Constable Care Team** to our school, where they worked with all students on road safety—a hot topic in our community! Students learned valuable lessons about pedestrian and bike safety, as well as how to safely use the new pedestrian rail crossing coming out of Whitby.

Also last week, we had the Bright Future STEM Team working with our senior students, giving them valuable insight into careers in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. A geologist spoke to students about her work in the mining industry, which captured everyone's interest. This was followed by a range of engaging, hands-on activities, including the use of VR headsets.



Two weeks ago, our Years 3–6 students engaged with the **Landcare Pesky Pests Team** to learn about introduced invasive plant and animal species, and their impact on the local environment.



We have five classes heading on an excursion to Scitech this term. Rooms 4 and 5 will attend on Thursday 28 May, while Rooms 3, 6 and 9 are scheduled for Friday 26 June. This excursion is an exciting opportunity for our students and is linked to the Science curriculum.

Our Room 1 students have been learning about ocean creatures this term. On Thursday 11 June they will be heading on an excursion to AQWA to get up close and personal with some marine creatures.

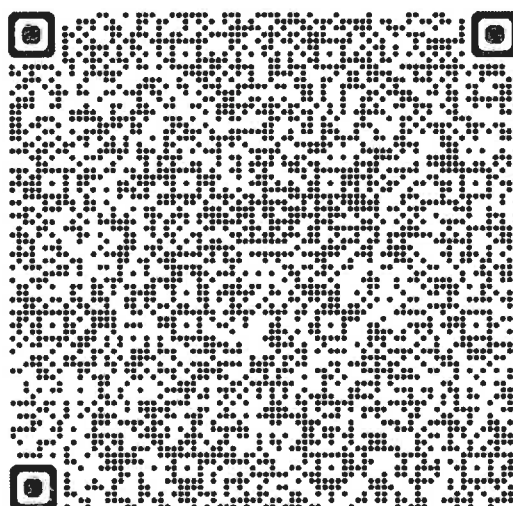

Easy lunchbox swaps to boost kids' fibre - without spending more.

### Ten easy lunchbox swaps to boost fibre

- Swap white bread for wholemeal or wholegrain varieties
- Replace sugary spreads like jam with hummus, avocado or nut butters (if nuts are allowed at school)
- Swap sugary snack bars for wholegrain cereal bites
- Choose plain popcorn instead of packets of chips or salty snacks
- Pack carrot sticks with hummus instead of packaged snacks
- Use wholemeal wraps instead of white wraps
- Replace flavoured yoghurt pouches with plain yoghurt and fresh fruit
- Use wholegrain crackers instead of refined varieties
- Swap processed snacks for trail mix, fruit bread or roasted legume snacks
- Use canned legumes such as baked beans instead of frozen pastry or party foods like chicken nuggets.

### How much fibre do kids need?

- Children aged 4–8 years need around 18 grams of fibre per day
- Children aged 9–13 years need 20–24 grams per day
